In the past 20 years, nearly 7,000 undocumented immigrants have died on the U.S.-Mexico border, including nearly 3,000 in Arizona's Sonoran Desert. Professor Brad Jones will share his experiences in providing humanitarian efforts on the border as well as discuss the migrant death crisis more generally in the context of U.S. immigration policy.
